Deadline Approaching for 2025 FRS Scholarship Application

The application process is completely online. All schools in the Pineland service area will receive notification of the scholarship award application. Additionally, the application link can be found on the Pineland website, www.pineland.net, under "News". The online application process and all associated documents must be finalized and uploaded no later than February 14, 2025.

Should a student residing and attending school in the Pineland service area be selected to receive one of the FRS General Scholarships, Pineland will contribute an additional \$500 to the award, bringing the total one-time scholarship award to \$2,500. In addition to the FRS General Scholarships, students may be eligible for one the following named scholarships; V+C Trust Scholarship, Diana Jo Dreyer Memorial Scholarship sponsored by INDATEL Services, Everett Kneece Scholarship, Sarah Tyree Good Neighbor Scholarship, Herbert and Isabel Bitz Memorial Scholarship, JSI Scholarship, and the Cronin Communications Scholarship. One application submission is sufficient to be eligible for all available scholarships.

During the online application process, students must choose the correct sponsoring company in the service area in which they are making application. 

The tour provides a forum for teens to meet and interact with their peers from other rural communities, as well as key legislative, regulatory, and government figures.





residing in a home with Pineland service will receive bonus points during the scoring process. Each student applicant will be expected to demonstrate leadership in organizations and community through volunteer activities, write an essay on the topic of Economic Development in Rural America; How Broadband Affects Daily Life in My Rural America, and obtain a letter of recommendation from his/her high school counselor. Students must be 15, 16, or 17 years old at the time of the trip.

The 2025 Youth Tour is scheduled for Monday, June 2 – Friday, June 6. During the tour, students will tour Washington D.C. and the surrounding area, including a trip to Mount Vernon, Home of George Washington; visit the Smithsonian Museums; tour multiple Memorials; attend a play at The Kennedy Center; meet with Federal Communications Commission and Congressional staff; and build relationships with their peers.

The application deadline for the Youth Tour is Monday, March 17, 2025.
